

Glilah

("Rolling" the Torah closed, and dressing it)

Start with the **Avnet** ("Belt", based on on the Kohein Gadol's belt).

*Put this on facing the front of the Torah,
which is facing away from you,
towards the magbiah (m)/ magbihah (f).*

then the **M'eel** (**Mantle**/Cover based on on the Kohein Gadol's belt).

Put this on facing the front of the Torah,

then the **Choshen** ("Breastplate", based on the stone studded gold square hanging on the Kohein Gadol's chest from chains on his shoulders),

Put this on facing the front of the Torah,

the **Yad** (**Hand**, which we use so as not to touch/smear the ink and parchment. Originally, the rabbis declared that a Torah scroll or Megillah was so holy that it taints the hands, but not other, non-Biblical scrolls),

the yad goes on the side of Breishit (the right side)

and last, the **Rimmon/im** ("Pomegranates" w/Bells, based on the hem of the Kohein Gadol's robe).
